



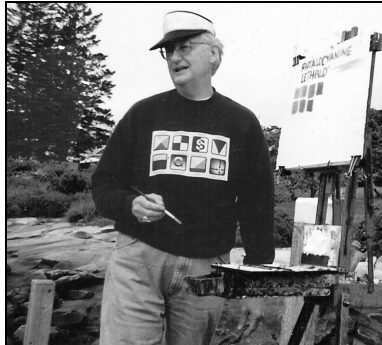
Tony van Hasselt Workshop

September 8 - 11, 2009

Workhouse Arts Center at Lorton, VA

Tuition: \$360



Tony van Hasselt will teach a plein air workshop at the Workhouse Art Center, Lorton, VA, in conjunction with the **Virginia Watercolor Society's 30th Exhibition**, which he will judge. The schedule will vary according to the weather, but we plan to travel each day to a preselected nearby location in our own vehicles. After a daily demo, participants are free to paint on their own while Tony circulates and assists on an individual basis. A daily critique will be held in the Workhouse classroom, which will also be available in the event of inclement weather. The Lorton area is rich with interesting painting venues: the banks of the Potomac and Occoquan Rivers, picturesque towns such as Occoquan, colonial churchyards, even the site of the former prison where the Workhouse Art Center has been developed.

Tony will take a maximum of **25** artists who will be chosen by **lottery** after the deadline. The workshop will be four days, Tuesday through Friday, from 9am until 5pm (3:30 pm on Friday). The fee is \$360 payable to VWS. Supply lists, maps and a list of local hotels will be sent promptly upon selection. A waiting list will be maintained in case of cancellations. Refunds will be given only if there is a replacement for your reservation. If you pay for the workshop but are not selected by lottery, please inform us whether to hold your check for a possible opening, tear it up, or return it.
