From the West (Richmond, Charlottesville)

Take Interstate 64 East to exit 267,
Turn right onto Settler's Landing Rd, go over bridge, through downtown Hampton (about 1.5 miles).
Turn left onto Kecoughtan Road, go about .5 miles to Thornette Street, make a left into CHTAC parking lot.
CHTAC shares the parking lot with the Hampton Public Library next door.

From the East (Norfolk, Virginia Beach)

Take Interstate 64 West to exit 267,
Turn left onto Settler's Landing Rd,
Turn left onto Kecoughtan Road, go about .5 miles to Thornette Street, make a left into CHTAC parking lot.
CHTAC shares the parking lot with the Hampton Public Library next door.

The Arts Center is on the corner of Victoria Blvd. and Kecoughtan Rd.

From the West (Richmond, Charlottesville)

Take Interstate 64 East to exit 268.
Turn left on Mallory Street.
Turn right onto Mellen Street.
The American Theatre is on the left.

From the East (Norfolk, Virginia Beach)

Take Interstate 64 West to exit 268.
See directions above.

From the East (I-664)

Take Interstate 64 East to exit 268.
See directions above.

Parallel parking is on the streets plus large lots are behind Mellen Street and Hope Street.
